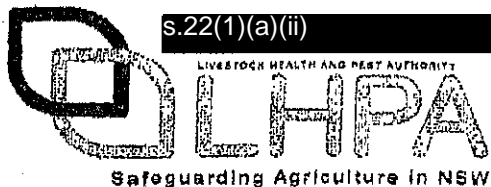

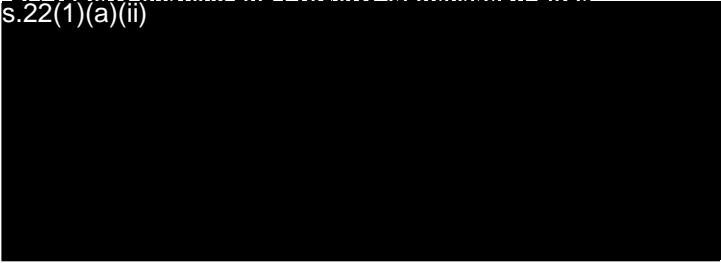

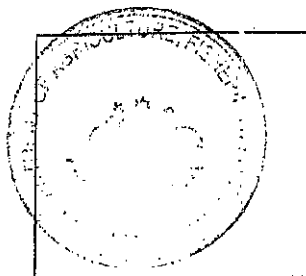

- The cattle originate from herds of origin free Bovine Brucellosis (*Brucella abortus*) and Bovine Tuberculosis.
- The cattle originate from which are free from Johne's Disease (Paratuberculosis) during the previous five (5) years.
- The cattle originate from herds which have been clinically free of Enzootic Bovine Leucosis (EBL) and bovine pasteurellosis for 24 months and Trichomoiasis, Vibriofetus, Leptospirosis, Bovine Herpes Virus type 1 (BHV 1), IBR/IPV, Bovine Viral Diarrhoea/Mucosal Disease (BVD/MD), Neosporosis and Para Influenza-3 (PI 3) for the last 12 months.
- During the previous 60 days, within a 150km radius of the property(s) of origin, there has been no clinical case/outbreak of bluetongue in cattle; and within a 10km radius there has been no clinical case/outbreak of bovine brucellosis (*Brucella abortus*) or bovine tuberculosis.
- The cattle were kept in a bluetongue-free zone for at least 60 days prior to shipment.
- The cattle are not animals to be killed under a national program for the eradication of disease.
