

VALE COMMENTS on Report 14 Jawan Indonesia August 2018

This was a low mortality voyage with no adverse weather or ship conditions reported. Space allowances did not conform to OIE Terrestrial Animal Health Code 2018

Loading

“It was observed that generally half of the cattle could lie down at any one time.”

VALE COMMENT:

This space allowance is inadequate. OIE recommendations on transport of animal by sea (Chapter 7.2) states that “When animals lie down, there should be enough space for every animal to adopt a normal lying posture.” Australia is a signatory to OIE and our Chief Veterinary Officer is the President of OIE.
